Following the movie, there will be time for audience discussion moderated by clinicians from the Harold C. Schott Foundation Eating Disorders Program.

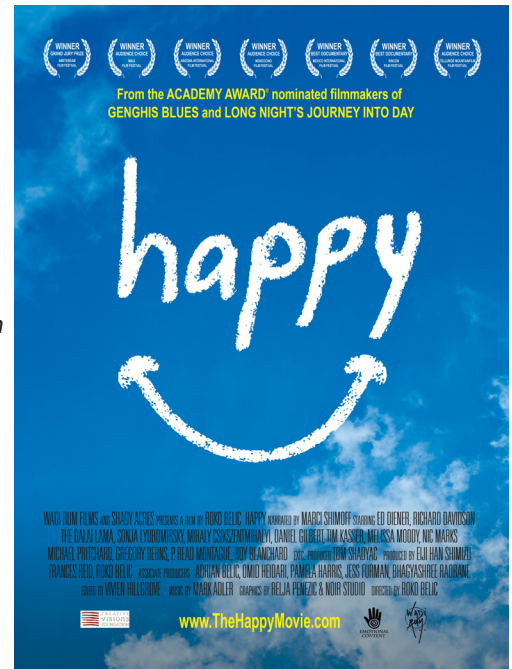
